

- Order 1 Welcome Susan Collazo, new City Secretary, to Joint Elections Commission
- Order 2 There were no public comments.
- Order 3 There were no accounts payable. Kylene's salary was discussed. Brandy Fannon made the motion to immediately raise the JEA salary the 6% budgeted last year. Nancy Wallace seconded. The motion carried and so ordered.
- Order 4 Came on for consideration the minutes from the last Joint Elections Commission meeting, July 17, 2024. Nancy Wallace made the motion to accept the minutes, Brandy Fannon seconded. Motion carried and so ordered.
- Order 5 Came on for consideration the Joint Elections Administrator, Kylene Wheeler's, report of the Joint Elections Commission.. She reported on new state and federal laws for elections. (See Attachment) Kylene will send out letters to PISD School Board members inviting them to join the Joint Elections Commission. She will also try to get on the school board agenda so that she can explain the role of the JEC and the benefits to the school to join. Kylene also related her goals for the coming year. Brandy Fannon made the motion to accept the report, Nancy Wallace seconded. Motion carried and so ordered.

Order 6 Came on for consideration the Joint Election Commissions budget.
With new and longer hours being mandated by the state, the salaries line
item was increased. The rest of the budget remained the same. Brandy
Fannon made the motion to accept the budget, Terri Laurence seconded.
The motion carried and so ordered.
