



A Regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Garza County, Texas was held on Monday, April 27, 2026 beginning at 9:00 a.m. at the Commissioners' Courtroom, 300 W. Order 9: Consider to approve Unclaimed Property Capital Credits for Counties. Section 74.602 of the Texas Property Code authorizes the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts to allocate a portion of the unclaimed capital credits received from electric cooperatives back to counties in cooperatives' service areas. A motion was made by Commissioner Williams and seconded by Commissioner Dalby to approve the Unclaimed Property Capital Credits for Counties. With a majority of the court members voting aye, the motion carried and so ordered. See attachment.
