None presented.

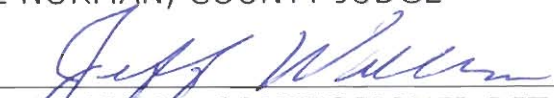

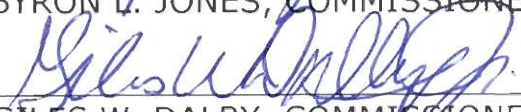
JEFF WILLIAMS, COMMISSIONER PCT. 1
